We are excited to announce the **2025 Annual Canadian National Kickboxing Championships** - the largest running Kickboxing Tournament in Canada!

This year, we are moving Nationals to a new location, The International Centre, near the Toronto Pearson Airport. We hope that this location will provide more convenience to our athletes traveling from all across Canada.

Athletes competing in the 2025 Nationals will have the chance to bring home a custom designed belt.

The Nationals will again feature the ring disciplines (K1 and Low Kick) in Junior, Intermediate, and Senior age divisions. Kick Light age divisions will include Cadet, Junior,

Intermediate, Senior, and Veteran athletes. As usual, we will offer two experience levels: novice and open class.

ADDITIONAL AWARDS!

Best Supporting Club Award – Most number of Entries

Top Female Senior Athlete - Top Male Senior Athlete - Top Intermediate Athlete - Top Junior Athlete

Only clubs registered for 2025 with WAKO Canada will be allowed to enter athletes.

All athletes must have a current WAKO Passport and 2025 Sticker Code (for ring sport) before entering the Nationals. If athletes are not registered, the discounted fees will not be accepted.

NOTE THE FOLLOWING POLICIES FOR THE 2025 NATIONALS

- Only participants registered for 2025 with WAKO Canada can register for the Nationals
- Three Participants are required to make a Nationals Division
- If there are less than 3 participants in a division – athletes will be moved to the closest discipline/category/weight division to make 3 participants
- Coaches will be notified immediately of any move
- Athletes must indicate their 1st – 2nd – 3rd Choice of Divisions when registering for the Nationals
